

T&Cs for Glamping Firepit & Log Burner (where applicable) use

I agree to the following terms & conditions for use of a firepit and log burner (where applicable) at the Dorset Hideaway Glamping:

- **This sheet needs to be signed before firepits & log burners can be used**
- I will not move the firepit from the gravel location it is in when I check in
- I will not place the firepit on the grass or decked areas at any time during my stay
- I will extinguish the firepit before midnight and not leave it to smoulder
- I understand that the firepit is for outdoor use only
- I will not use the log burner or firepit if I am under the influence of alcohol
- I will not burn anything in the firepit or log burner other than the logs provided or purchased on site to comply with the site insurance terms [Our logs are 'Ready to Burn' certificated and are backed by the HETAS & the Stove industry Alliance & dried to a moisture level below 20% so they do not smoke]
- I will NOT bring any logs or any other wood onto site and use to burn in our fire pits or log burners. I understand that if the Dorset Hideaway see evidence of this the firepit will be removed and I will lose part of my security deposit
- I will not use saucepans, frying pans or baking trays provided in my kitchenette or from the shared kitchen/diner to cook on the fire pit – I will only use the foil trays provided for BBQing or bring my own trays; any damage to saucepans, frying pans etc from this misuse will be charged for
- I will not throw anything onto the firepit
- I will not use flammable liquids on the firepit or log burner
- I will keep the firepit clear of debris and keep logs & firelighters at a safe distance
- I understand that the outside of the firepit can get extremely hot when in use and I will not attempt to lift or move it at any time
- I understand I can toast Crumpets and Marshmallows on the firepit at my own risk
- I understand the log burner is for heating purposes only
- I will not place anything on top of or in front of the log burner at any time
- I understand the log burner door must be kept closed always for fire safety (other than when adding a log to the fire)
- I will keep logs & kindling in the metal storage containers provided and away from the log burner
- I know that I can purchase matches, lighters & firelighters from reception and that I can also buy more logs & kindling from the Dorset Hideaway by making contact through the advertised number
- I will use the heat protective gloves provided to open & close the log burner when it is lit
- I have been told where the fire extinguisher is
- I will ensure one person is responsible for lighting and extinguishing all fires in the firepit & log burner and will not leave fires or the log burner unattended
