

T&Cs for Touring & Camping Firepit Hire

I agree to the following terms & conditions for use of a firepit at the Dorset Hideaway:

- **This sheet needs to be signed before firepits can be hired or used**
- I will not place the firepit on grass I will ensure it is on a gravel area
- I will extinguish the firepit before midnight and not leave it to smoulder
- I understand that the firepit is for outdoor use only
- I will not use the firepit if I am under the influence of alcohol
- I will not burn anything in the firepit other than the logs provided or purchased on site to comply with the site insurance terms [Our logs are 'Ready to Burn' certificated and are backed by the HETAS & the Stove industry Alliance & dried to a moisture level below 20% so they do not smoke]
- I will NOT bring any logs or any other wood onto site and use to burn in our fire pits. I understand that if the Dorset Hideaway see evidence of this the firepit will be removed and there will be no refunds
- I will not throw anything onto the firepit
- I will not use flammable liquids on the firepit
- I will keep the firepit clear of debris and keep logs & firelighters at a safe distance
- I understand that the outside of the firepit can get extremely hot when in use and I will not attempt to lift or move it at any time
- I understand I can toast Crumpets and Marshmallows on the firepit at my own risk
- I know that I can purchase matches, lighters & firelighters from reception and that I can also buy more logs & kindling from the Dorset Hideaway by making contact through the advertised number
- I have been told where fire extinguishers area and have a copy of the site plan with these locations clearly marked
- I will ensure one person is responsible for lighting and extinguishing all fires in the firepit and will not leave firepit unattended
